



HEALTHCARE ORGANIZATION PROVISIONING ON THE DPP

The information described throughout this document is directed towards users who have administrative responsibilities within the organization, and will be in charge of performing tasks on the Direct Provisioning Portal (DPP). This document is to be used in conjunction with the additional documents provided by the DataMotion Support staff. These documents are briefly described in a *Documentation* section located *on page 17*.

Your Health Care Organization will be granted the capability to provision companies onto the DPP. All companies that are created will be sub-companies or children to the initial tenant or parent company that was created by a DataMotion Officer. Upon successful creation and validation, every organization can have users created under them so long as the proper certificates are acquired. Information regarding these topics are contained in separate documents titled **Creating Users on the DPP** and **Performing Certificate Requests on the DPP** respectively. These documents are provided by DataMotion Support as supplementary material so that organizations can begin using the DataMotion Direct service as quickly as possible.

Prerequisites

Before beginning the provisioning process it is advised that the following actions be completed, and specific materials be close at hand before beginning. You should complete these prerequisites at this time if they have not been fulfilled already.

- Have an EIN, Organization NPI, or business license available.
- Have as much information regarding the organization at hand in order to make the first step easier.
- If a Trusted Agent is to be created during this process, have a signed Declaration of Identity Document on hand. If you do not have this document, you may retrieve a blank one from the Support page that can be reached via the corresponding link at the top of the web portal and to the left of your username.
- If a Trusted Agent is to be created during this process, have two government issued photo IDs saved as images (.PNG, .JPG, etc.) on a device.

NOTE: To avoid the need for two government issued photo IDs, use a passport for Photo ID.

• If you would like to add a domain during this procedure, have the appropriate domain name setup and ready for use.





First Time Users


If this is the very first time that you are interacting with the DPP, a DataMotion Officer will have performed the *Creating an Organization* section and all of its steps for you. If this is the case, you should go to the *Registering an Organization* section *on page 9* to complete the organizational provisioning process.

NOTE: For clarification, a first time user in this sense is the very first time that a company has any interaction with the DPP. Meaning that this will be the first time anyone in the organization is given an account to sign in and complete the process of registering their tenant company.

Creating an Organization

Creating a Healthcare Organization is the first step in the overall process to fully utilize all of the services provided by DataMotion Direct. Every organization that is provisioned on the DPP must have this process completed by either a Trusted Agent or Administrator user within the company before being able to proceed to the *Registering an Organization* process.

1. On the "Home" screen, select the host company for the new tenant company to be added. This will most likely be your company. Then select the Add Org button to begin the application process.



2. The Create a Healthcare Organization page will be displayed.




- 3. Read this page carefully, and gather all of the materials listed under the **What You'll Need** section (if the *Prerequisites* section has been satisfied, this step is already complete).
- 4. Click the Yes! Begin button to begin at Step 1: Organization Information (Create HCO).





Step 1: Organization Information (Create Organization)



- 1. If you know the NPI of the HCO you are trying to add, enter it into the NPI field to prepulate most of the information on this page.
 - » If not, then manual input of the data will be required.
- 2. Enter the information of the HCO to be added into the appropriate fields. Only the Name field is required.
 - » It is recommended that you input as much information for as many fields as possible. Doing so will speed up the *Registering an Organization* process later on.





- » User Types: These define the types of users within the organization, for ONC/MU2 reporting. If the organization consists of both Clinical and Non-Clinical users, select Clinical. Similarly, if the organization consists of both EP (Eligible Professionals) and Non-EP, select EP.
- » Support Contacts: The information in this section is optional; however, in the case that any technical or billing issues arise, contact information here will greatly expedite solving any issues.
- 3. Select Next, and proceed to Step 2: Domain Information (Create HCO).

NOTE: Clicking the Next button will commit the creation of this HCO to the DPP. This means that the registration process for this organization must be completed with the Name that it was given in this step. Please ensure that the name of this organization is correct to avoid having to restart this process.

- » Use the Select a TA: drop-down to choose the TA for the HCO. The Organization, Phone, and Contact Email will be auto populated upon selection.

- 1. Input either the organization's NPI or EIN into the appropriate field. If it is not possible to submit the previous choices, then use the **Submit** button to email the license to DataMotion.
- 2. Click the **I agree to the terms above** checkbox.





3. Click Next to complete the process.

NOTE: Once an Organization is validated by a DM Officer, only the co-branding, HPD options, and the contact information can be edited. Please ensure that all information is properly entered into the portal before selecting the Submit button.





Registering an Organization

Successful creation of an HCO will send a notification email to the TA that was designated during the creation process that informs them an HCO requires registration. If a new TA was created for this HCO then that TA will have to create a password before they are brought to the appropriate registration page. In either case successful login will navigate the TA to the Register a Healthcare Organization page and display a page outlining the general procedure and the information you must have prepared in order to meet the requirements of the registration process. If you do not have all of the required information being asked for on the page, it will not be possible to complete the process.

Step 3: Authorized User (Register Organization)

This step of the process varies depending on the decision made during the Step 3: Authorized User (Create Organization) part of the process. If the decision was to have a TA assigned to the HCO being created then this entire step is not required. If the decision was to create a new TA for this HCO, then this step must be followed in its entirety.

- 1. Enter accurate information into all fields on this page that have a * symbol.
 - » The Photo ID Type drop-down contains the types of ID that are acceptable for submission which are a Driver's License, Passport, or State ID.
 - » In some cases a second ID may be required depending on which Photo ID Type was selected. This only occurs for certain states.

NOTE: To avoid the need for two government issued photo IDs, use a passport for Photo ID.

- 2. Upload the signed DoID which must be in one of the formats specified on the page (.pdf, .png, .jpg, and .tif are currently accepted).
- 3. Click Next to proceed to Step 4: How would you like your alerts to be communicated?

NOTE: Ensure that the DolD being submitted is fully accurate and validated (signed by a notary or existing Trusted Agent) before clicking the Next button. If not then the entire process will have to be restarted beginning with Step 1: Organization Information (Create Organization). This is because once the DolD is submitted during this step, it is not possible to remove it and submit a different one.

- 1. Select how notifications should be received.
 - » Email Notifications will send all relevant notifications to the email address provided during Step 3: Authorized User (Register Organization).
 - » Web Notifications will submit all notifications to the web UI itself.
- 2. Click Next to proceed to Step 5: Verify Your Organization (Register Organization).

Step 5: Verify Your Organization (Register Organization)

The information provided during this step should match the information that was provided during *Step 4: Verify Your Organization (Create Organization)* part of the process. It is possible to change the information during this step if desired, however it is not advised. The reason for this being that when the organization is reviewed by a DataMotion Officer it could cause some confusion to as why there is a discrepancy present in this step if the information provided is not congruent in both steps. This does not mean that the registration will be a failure, but it could cause delays in the validation process.

1. Enter either the NPI, EIN, or Business License of the organization being registered.





- » Submitting the Business License will open an email client on your computer when the Submit button is clicked. Attach the organization's Business License to this email and send it to the designated party at DataMotion. Once that task is completed, click the **Business License Submitted** checkbox.
- 2. Click **Next** to complete the application.

Glossary

Throughout this document numerous terms have been used that correspond to specific user roles, functions, and technical terms that are used on the DataMotion Direct Provisioning Portal. This section provides an overview of these terms for reference.

- Direct Provisioning Portal (DPP) Acronym used for the DataMotion Direct Provisioning Portal. This is the more common name that the portal is referred by within the DataMotion HISP.
- DataMotion Officer An individual within the DataMotion HISP that is responsible for performing validation checks on domains, certificates, and users.
- Administrator (Admin) The user role on the DPP that is normally used to administer the companies to which the user with the role is a part of or is the parent of within the company hierarchy.
- Trusted Agent (TA) The only user that is able to perform certificate requests on the DPP for the creation of users on a specific domain.
- Declaration of Identity Document (DoID) A validation form that is used to prove the identity of the user that is to be given a Direct Address or the status and powers of a TA.
- Comma Separated Value (CSV) File format type used to submit a spreadsheet containing the information of users to be added on the DPP.

Appendix

During the creation and registration processes described in this document, there are a number of requirements listed which contain elements not fully detailed during the instructions. These requirements are presented during *Step 1: Organization Information (Create Organization)* and are as follows:

- Organization Type:
 - » Acute Care Hospital The organization is a short-term hospital facility with appropriate medical staff and equipment to provide diagnosis, treatment, and care
 - » Ambulatory Practice/Entity The organization is an outpatient medical practice commonly viewed as a traditional doctor's office, but can include other outpatient outlets such as emergency clinics.
 - » Non hospital Clinical Lab The organization is a diagnostics laboratory that performs imaging (MRI, CT, PET, etc.) or clinical diagnostics such as bloodwork tests.
 - » Other Health Care Related Organization Can be any other health care related facility that does not fit into the descriptions of the other three organization types.
- HIPAA Compliance Type:
 - » HIPAA Covered Entity Defined as a Health Plan, Health Care Clearinghouse, or Health Care Provider that electronically transmits health information. If the





Organization Type selected falls into one of these categories, select this compliance type.

- » HIPAA Business Associate Defined as an individual person or entity (company, group of persons) that provides services to a HIPAA Covered Entity where protected health information is involved. If the Organization Type selected provides any form of service to an organization where protected health information is involved and that organization is considered a covered entity, then select this Compliance Type.
- » Other HIPAA Entity Can be defined as a hybrid entity which meets the qualifications of a Covered Entity but only for certain sections of the organization. Common examples would include university's which possess medical research laboratories or hospitals as extensions to the university itself.

User Types:

- » ONC (Clinical vs. Non-Clinical) The clinical user is selected if the users within an organization provide healthcare services directly to patients including diagnosis, treatment, care, etc. If no users within the organization do provide such healthcare services to patients, select Non-Clinical.
- » Meaningful Use (EP vs. Non-EP) Refers to whether the users within an organization are considered eligible professionals by guidelines set by CMS (the Center for Medicare & Medicaid Services). These guidelines are listed <u>HERE</u> for convenience. Should none of the users within the organization meet these guidelines select Non-EP.

Documentation

This section provides a brief overview of the documents provided by the DataMotion Support staff that provide essential instructions to be used in conjunction with this document.

- Performing Certificate Requests on the DPP: This document specifically describes the process
 of requesting certificates using the DataMotion Direct Provisioning Portal. Includes
 information and instructions for Organization and Address based certificates.
- Creating Users on the DPP: This document specifically describes the process of adding users to the DPP. It includes instructions for every user type on the DPP.

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
